JROTC Hall of Fame

Objective: To provide real life role models for our students of graduates who have utilized the knowledge, skills and abilities (KSA) taught in JROTC to make an impact in our world today.

Establish a Standing Review Committee to operate the Hall of Fame:

Members: CCHS SAI (Executive Secretary)
CCHS President (Committee Chairman)
CCHS Principal
CCHS Alumni Association President or designated representative
Alumni Associate
The Committee could vote to add additional members, i.e., another faculty member, Army Instructor, alumnus.

Responsibilities:

The Standing Review Committee will announce a Call for Nominees each year.
The Standing Review Committee will meet to review applicants and vote to select applicants for initiation.
Based on strength of nominees, Committee will normally accept 1 – 3 each year for induction.

Selection Criteria: Nominees must meet the following criteria:

Graduated from Central Catholic High School
Completed 4 years of JROTC
Achieved notable accomplishments in a field such as education, religion, business, law, politics, military, etc.
Posthumous Nominations will be accepted

Nomination Procedure:

Any CCHS Alumnus or Faculty or Administration Member may nominate candidates.
See Nomination Form
Nomination packet must include detailed information on the accomplishments of the nominee. Highlight use of KSA taught in JROTC.
Nomination packet must include a proposed short biography of the candidate.
Nomination will include most current photo, if possible.

Timeline:

Announce nomination process and timeline each year in January
Close nomination process each year at time of the Blue and White Ball
Announce selectees each year at end of September
Induct honorees in conjunction with Corps Day Review

Selection:

The committee will meet, review applications and vote on all nominees. A unanimous vote for a nominee will be required to accept him for induction. Unless there are unusual circumstances, no more than three nominees will be inducted each year. The committee may request additional information on any nominee and delay a decision until that information is found.

Recognition:

Selected inductees will be posted on the designated wall in the JROTC hall. The posted recognition will include a photo from their senior year on the left, the most current photo available in the same size on the right. Below the photos, the following will be printed: the name, graduation year, highest position/rank held in JROTC, team participation, position/accomplishment after school and then a short biography.
