Overview: This course continues the (LET) Leadership Education Training begun in your LET 1 and 2 years. Emphasis is placed on the performance of leadership tasks performed in cooperation with LET 4 cadets. Topics covered will include, but are not limited to: (Unit 1) Citizenship in Action; (Unit 2) Leadership Theory and Application; (Unit 3) Foundations for Success; (Unit 6) Citizenship in American History and Government; and (Field Manual 3-21.5) Drill and Ceremonies. Leadership theory and other skills taught in the classroom should be practiced during our leadership labs, which are a combination of Drill and Ceremonies, Service Learning, and other performance opportunities.

Quarter Grades:

Grade category

Tests & Mandatory Events	30% of overall grade
Quizzes & Portfolios	20% of overall grade
Uniform Inspections	30% of overall grade
Performance	20% of overall grade

Tests & Mandatory Events: Tests will be given at the end of each quarter. Tests given at the end of 2nd and 4th quarter will be comprehensive semester exams.

Mandatory events include: Summer Leadership Seminar---3-7 Aug 09; Brigade Drills--- **(30 Sept, 11 Nov, 24 Feb, & 5 May)** ; Corps Day / Night--- **(24 Oct)**; Military Ball--- **(6 Mar)**; Veterans Parade---**(7 Nov)**; Battle of the Flowers Parade--- **(23 Apr)**

These events count as a uniform inspection grade, and a performance grade.

NOTE: Mandatory events are listed in your school calendar. Written excuses must be turned in before the end of the 1st week of school. If you have a true emergency on the day of an event, you must turn in your excuse the next day back to school. (Having a job and being scheduled to work is not an excuse; you need to request these days off.)

Quizzes & Portfolios: You will have a quiz after each block of instruction. At the end of the 2nd and 4th QTR's, a quiz grade will be applied for the maintenance of required portfolios.

NOTE: Anytime you miss a test or a quiz due to absence, it is your responsibility to make arrangements for a make-up within two days of returning to class. If you do not, you will receive a zero for your grade.

Uniform Inspections: All cadets start off with 100 points. For each minor uniform violation, 5 points will be deducted. Not being in the complete uniform, not being clean shaven, or not having a regulation haircut & style, will be assessed 25 points each. Not wearing the uniform will be assessed 100 points. **If you are absent from school on a uniform day, (This includes weekly uniform days & mandatory events) you must wear your uniform the next day they come back to school.**

Performance: Your performance will be evaluated in the classroom, during leadership labs, and during all JROTC functions. Cadets start each day with 100 points. Infractions will be assessed a loss of points as listed below.

Tardy To Class	(-25 points)
Failure to Follow Instructions / School Rules / JROTC Regulations	(-50 points)
Unprepared For Class	(-50 points)
Sleeping / Laying Head Down	(-100 points)
Disrespectful / Distracting	(-100 points)

Semester Grades: IAW school standards, i.e., each quarter grade = 40%, + semester exam grade = 20%.

1. Don't be tardy to class.
2. Follow all instructions, school rules, and JROTC regulations.
3. Be prepared for class. (See "Required Materials" below)
4. No sleeping or laying your head down.
